



Overland Hike 2026 – Application Form

Who is the Overland Hike for?

The Overland Hike is open to teams of 4 Scouts or 4 Explorer Scouts.

The 2026 Overland Hike is open to Scouts aged 12-14½ years old (born between 1 October 2011 and 1 April 2014) and Explorer Scouts aged 13½ -18 years old (born between 1 April 2008 and 1 October 2012). A Scout aged between 13½ and 14½ may enter either competition.

How to enter

1. Complete a separate entry form overleaf for each team being entered into The Hike and post it to:

2. The entry fee of £75 per team is payable by bank transfer. So, we can easily identify your payment please use OH26 followed by first 8 digits of Troop/Unit name e.g. 1st Gilwell Scout troop would be: OH261Gilwell as the payment reference. Payments to be sent using the following bank details:

Teams will only be entered once a completed Application Form and payment are received.

3. The closing date for entries is Sunday 8th March 2026, after this date refunds cannot be made.
4. The Hike is limited to 70 teams. Once all the places have been allocated teams will be placed on a waiting list. Team start times are allocated in the order that complete applications (form and payment) are received.
